


1. When was your best feeling?

2. What did your child tell you about the camp?



- He told us about the accommodation, the football matches and the friendship with the Swedish boys, the trips and of course from the flight with the plane.
- She told us enthusiastic about the super accommodation and sport possibilities. She was inspired from the other children and the hospitality.
- His first sentence was: well Mama, I missed you, but I didn't want to go home! "He liked it very much, especially to contact not German speaking kids. He likes this challenge and he is missing his new friends.
- He liked special the ride with the draisine and the flight. He talked with a Swedish child in English. He was deep impressed from the blind Italian boy and his play on the keyboard.
- At the camp were very nice houses with straw roofs, a fantastic lake, everything was very clean and tidy. The weather was very good for a swim every day. They had tasty meals at a restaurant with starter, main course and dessert. She told us from a great

middle age party at a castle and a boring flight museum. But she liked the technical museum very much.

They tried swimming in the lake, they visited a farm, they tried riding a horse and a carriage. Every evening there was a small party and also couple of warm up exercises in the morning. My daughter was celebrating her birthday during this camp and they organized a birthday party for her and two girls from Sweden, who also had their birthdays. Children saw historical motorbikes and bicycles. They also visited school in Ořechov, where they met their pen friends. They took a boat trip on a small river and made miniatures of boats, which they then let go with the flow of the river. They used English for talking to German friends. They made new friends with handicapped kids.
